

CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR ERASMUS+ MOBILITY SCHOLARSHIPS FOR BACHELOR'S DEGREE STUDENTS OF THE FACULTY OF IMA AT SAARLAND UNIVERSITY IN 2026

1. Conditions of the Mobility

The Mobility Scholarship is for UFAR students enrolled in the 3rd year of studies at the Faculty of IMA for the 2025-2026 academic year. The mobility is planned for the 2nd semester of the 2025-2026 academic year.

The financial conditions of the mobility grant are as follows:

- Return economy class ticket up to a maximum of 530 euros;
- Monthly grant of €800.

2. Eligibility criteria

- 1. Submission of the application file within the deadline;
- 2. Enrollment in the 3rd year of an IMA degree (at the time of application);
- 3. Having an annual GPA equal to or higher than 14/20 in the 1st and 2nd years of the Bachelor's degree;
- 4. Having an overall average equal to or higher than 16/20 in English in the 1st and 2nd years of the Bachelor's degree;
- 5. Having a B2 level of English (a document attesting to the level acquired may be required later, if required by Saarland University).
- 6. B2 level of French will be a priority;
- 7. A2-B1 level of German will be a priority.
- 8. Absence of debts to the university (including having paid tuition fees for the 2025-2026 academic year before the application deadline).

Documents to be provided for the application file:

- Updated CV in English;
- Cover Letter in English.

4. How to submit applications?

Applications must be submitted:

- Electronically, at the email address <u>Ofelya.Aslibekyan@pers.ufar.am</u>, mentioning *"Saarland Mobility Application"* as the subject line of the e-mail, as well as to the Director of Education at <u>direction etudes@ufar.am</u> and to the Head of International Relations at <u>international@ufar.am</u>.
- All documents submitted electronically must be in PDF format.
- Using their UFAR student e-account. No application submitted using an email address other than the one provided by UFAR will not be considered.

5. Selection criteria by the jury

- Personal presentation and motivation (5 points);
- Extracurricular and professional activities (5 points);
- Language skills (5 points);
- Maturity, Resilience, speech quality (5 points).

6. Timeline and Process

- Application deadline: *November 25, 2025, 6:00 p.m.*
- Interview and language test (if necessary) will take place on *November 26-28, 2025.*
- Interviews will last for 10 minutes. The dates of the interviews will be announced later.

Note:

Students selected for this mobility will in no way be exempted from the special requirements required by the UFAR academic program to move on to the next year (e.g., DELF B2). It is up to the students to organize themselves accordingly.
